

Northrop Grumman Engineering Scholarship Qualifications

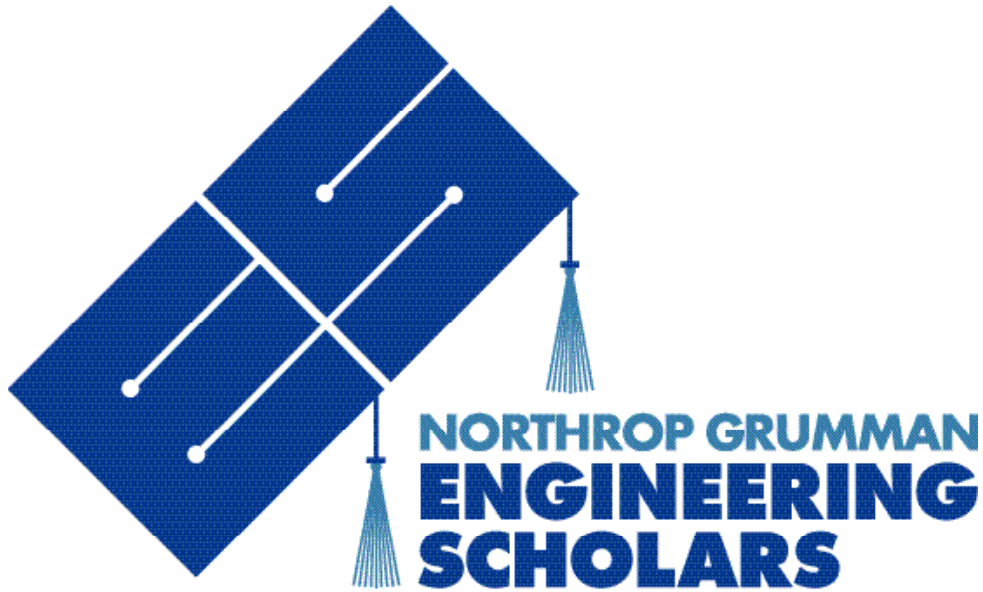
Northrop Grumman will award a \$10,000 scholarship to each of two graduating seniors enrolled in Erie or Niagara County, New York high schools. The funds are to be used for tuition, books, and/or room and board at the institution of higher education chosen by the recipient. A committee of Northrop Grumman Corporation employees will select the winners.

Applicant Qualifications:

- Must be a resident of Erie or Niagara County, New York
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must be a graduating senior of a public or accredited private high school in Erie or Niagara County, New York
- Must plan to attend an accredited college or university as a full-time student in an approved engineering program
- Must have a minimum composite SAT score of 1700 or ACT score of 27
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 (grades 9-12)

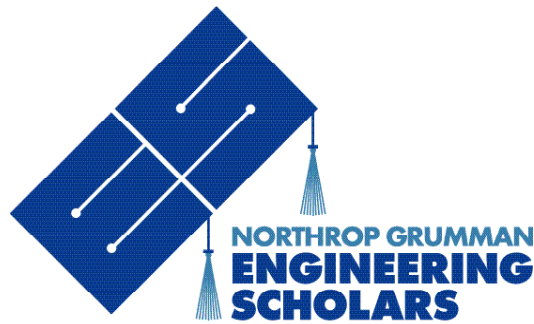
In the event the recipient does not complete the school year, any remaining funds are to be returned to the Northrop Grumman Scholarship Fund.

- Complete the Student Application by typing or printing the requested information. You may add additional pages if needed.
- Prepare a typewritten 500 word essay on your career goals.
This essay will receive particular attention and should demonstrate your ability to organize your thoughts into a well-developed presentation.
- Have a school official (guidance counselor, principal, vice principal) complete and sign the Transcript Information Form and provide a copy of your transcripts.
- Collect at least three letters of recommendation. One letter of recommendation must be from your school's principal or the head of the math or science department. The other two letters of recommendation may be from teachers, employers, or community leaders.
- Complete the Checklist and Signature Page. We advise that you work with your school counselor in preparing this application packet and require his or her signature. In addition, we require your signature and the signature of a parent or legal guardian to verify that the information in your packet is correct and that you meet the requirements of the program.
- All forms must be completed in order to be considered.

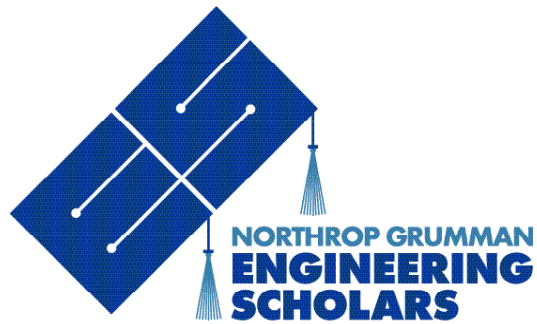

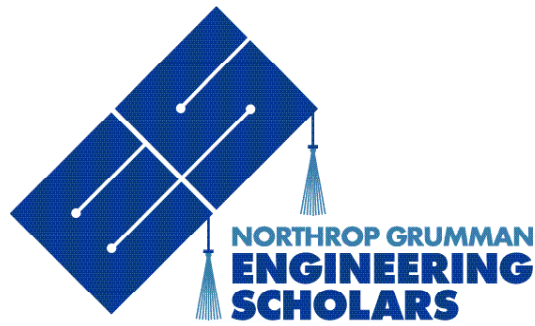
